

BREEDERS' CUP BETTING CHALLENGE

Friday, November 6 & Saturday, November 7

FAQS

What is the Challenge buy-in?

This is a "real money" Challenge. Players are required to put up \$10,000. \$2,500 is applied towards the prize money pool of which 100% is paid out. \$7,500 is the player's bankroll for betting. At the conclusion of the tournament, any dollar amount remaining in the bankroll – whether it grows to 30,000 or falls to \$100 – remains the property of the player.

How many entries are available?

The Challenge is capped at 80 entries.

What is the prize money?

Total prize money is guaranteed at \$225,000 (A minimum of \$25,000 in additional funds added) and the top ten finishers will receive:

1st - \$125,000; 2nd - \$40,000; 3rd - \$20,000; 4th - \$12,000; 5th - 8,000; 6th to 10th - \$4,000

What is the format?

A minimum of \$600 must be bet per race on at least 5 races on Friday, November 6. A minimum of \$900 must be bet per race on at least 5 races on Saturday, November 7. Win, Place, Show, Exacta and Trifecta wagering only.

Can I bet less than the stated minimums on additional contest races?

A player that bets more than five races each day may bet less than the stated minimums on other contest races as long as the player bets the required minimum wager amounts for five races each day.

What races are available for wagering?

Only Santa Anita races on Friday, November 6 and Saturday, November 7, are allowed. The final Challenge race is the Ladies' Classic on Friday and the Classic on Saturday.

Where is the contest held?

The Challenge is held in the private Baldwin Terrace Room. However, if you prefer to sit elsewhere, your account wagering card will work at any self-service machine throughout the facility.

Is there power and wireless access available for laptops in the contest room?

Yes. Please request through tournament director.

Can I bring a guest?

The contest room is for registered players only. However, for each entrant, the BC will provide two seats (includes admission).

How do I reserve a spot in the Challenge?

A non-refundable deposit for \$500 is required to confirm your spot in the Challenge. To obtain an entry form, go to www.santaanita.com/bcbc. The \$500 deposit will be credited as part of your bankroll.

Can I enter more than once?

A maximum of two entries per person is allowed.

Where do I stay?

How many NTRA/DRF National Championship entries are awarded?

The top SIX finishers will receive entry into the 2010 NTRA/DRF National Handicapping Championship in Las Vegas plus a \$1,000 travel/hotel stipend.

Is this event part of the NHC Tour?

The event is part of the NHC Tour and contestants will earn tour points.

When is the remaining balance due?

By November 1.
