## RACE APPRAISAL

**ANALYSIS:** The key to this race is deciding what to do with **Scottish Diamond**. Do you bet to win? Single him in the exotics? Many are likely to do so, but we're going to take a stand against the impressive last-out winner. Why? Because he's double dropped in class off a strong win, shows just work since raced, faces plenty of other speed and is likely to be over bet. Instead, we'll opt for class climber **Craig's Storm**. That one has taken two straight, with his last a win over \$12,500 claimers. He's strong on numbers and boasts the running style (mid-pack) that should benefit

from today's likely "race shape" (fast early/slow late). Make **Storm** the HF 15a. **Russian Liquor** beat tougher Aug 6, ran well Aug 30 and shows up for \$6,000 more than the price claimed in July. The good form and drop in class makes him one to fear. **Saxophone** has never shown that he's this good, but right now the form is sharp and the race should set up well for him. **Analysis by Jack Brohamer**  
**CLOSERS:** Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Craig's Storm :23.5 - Deluxe Cat :24.0.

## HORSE COMMENTS

**Saxophone** is double jumped in class after winning two of her last three, most recently vs. \$10,000 stock Aug 28. The gelding has some positive history over the course, but also seems to lack the "Past Class" to make a successful jump to this level. Still, the form is solid.

**Craig's Storm** won both starts at the Del Mar stand, with his most recent coming against \$12,500 stock. The race puts him close on paper and regular rider Rosario continues to string along. Perhaps he's ready to finally get that first win here at Santa Anita.

**To The Penny** couldn't hold off Craig's Storm when runner-up in that Sept 7 \$12,500 claimer. The form is solid and the numbers continue to climb. Consider the quick gelding in the Trifecta on the raise.

**Acquire The Fire** was up close for a half-mile before tiring when double dropped in class to face this kind Aug 23. At one point this guy loves to win races, but currently he's riding an eight-race losing streak. The blinkers that went back on last time come back off.

**Russian Liquor**, who is down one class rung, is still in for \$6,000 more than the price claimed in July. The form has been pretty good and the numbers are solid. While Rosario winds up sticking with Craig's Storm, the replacement isn't too shabby.

**Deluxe Cat** finished in the back half of the field when beaten less than two lengths in a \$20,000 seller at Fairplex Park Sept 16. The slide down the class ladder continues and the numbers remain soft.

**Baroda Court** wired soft \$12,500 "non-winners of two" sellers Aug 26. A last-out win is always a positive, but this one is last on paper under the imaginary wire. There is other speed signed up that figures to push him along, too.

**Scottish Diamond**, from a cagey barn, is double dropped in class after winning in the clear Aug 30. The drop in class off such a fine performance isn't a good sign, he's facing other speed and is likely to be over bet. He's worked just once since raced as well. We'll take a stand against him.
