<b>ST23</b> W 5 P 4 S 1	W 0 P 0 S 0	CATALINA FOG - Had things going smartly in the winter/spring in Northern California as he won 4 of 5 starts. Things haven't gone as well since moving to Southern California, including finishing sixth in a spot like this at Del Mar on Aug. 27.	
<b>ST15</b> W 2 P 3 S 3	W 0 P 0 S 2	UNCLE JEEP - Has the look of a contender. He dueled and faltered to seventh in a route at Del Mar on July 23 after 2 1/2 months on the bench. He was claimed that day and subsequently has finished third for \$20,000 and for \$16,000. This further drop in class should help.	
<b>ST14</b> W 4 P 1 S 2	W 1 P 1 S 0	RUN OVER YOU - Bounced back to form at Fairplex on Sept. 20 after failing to threaten tougher in 3 Del Mar starts when he dropped to the \$10,000 level, dueled and drew away. He moves back up in class and has won on synthetic (3 of his 4 wins).	
<b>ST17</b> W 4 P 4 S 4	W 0 P 1 S 0	LET'S PICK UP THE PACE - Was quite productive here during the winter/spring meet including beating \$20,000 foes on Jan. 19 and a pair of thirds against tougher. He ran on to be fourth in a spot like this at Del Mar on Aug. 27 and may be coming up to his best.	
<b>ST 7</b> W 1 P 0 S 2	W 1 P 0 S 2	SAINT CHOCOLATE - Finished full of run to beat maidens at Del Mar on Aug. 26. That run was flattered as three foes he beat that day came right back to win. He faces winners for the first time, however, and his lack of speed puts him at a tactical disadvantage.	
<b>ST 6</b> W 2 P 1 S 0	W 2 P 0 S 0	ECHO WEST - Fits well in here. He won 2 straight at Hollywood Park last fall but then wasn't seen for over 8 months. He came back and ran eighth for \$20,000 at Del Mar on Aug. 29 and fourth for \$20,000 at Fairplex on Sept. 18. This class drop may be the key.

<b>ST25</b> W 5 P 2 S 5	W 1 P 0 S 0	SIX PACK ABS - Moves further down in class. He won here on March 13 and then was fifth in the Grade II Potrero Grande Handicap here on April 4. He was gone 4 months and hasn't been as sharp in 3 starts since but the class drop today should help.	
<b>ST18</b> W 2 P 2 S 4	W 0 P 1 S 0	PROFESSNL COURTESY - Returns after 5 months on the bench. He'll need to come back with improved form as he tailed off during the winter/spring. He ran ninth in his last start, which came in a spot similar to this, at Hollywood Park on May 2.	
<b>ST16</b> W 4 P 5 S 1	W 0 P 3 S 1	YANKEE VISIONARY - Looks to make amends after finishing sixth as the 8-5 favorite against tougher at Del Mar on Sept. 7. He's surely capable of better and 2 of his 4 wins have come sprinting on this track. The class level and shorter trip help his cause.	
<b>ST11</b> W 2 P 1 S 0	W 1 P 1 S 0	ENGINE SIXTY NINE - Has speed and comes here seemingly peaking. After some modest form in the spring/early summer he beat restricted claimers at Del Mar on Aug. 13 and then was second (beaten just a nose) for \$10,000 there on Aug. 28.	
<b>ST14</b> W 8 P 3 S 1	W 4 P 0 S 0	COPA DE PLATA - Looks tough again. He's come back strong after nearly 17 months on the bench, winning all 3 return outings including beating \$16,000 foes at Del Mar on Aug. 23. He was claimed that day but was bought back by these connections.

<b>ST15</b> W 2 P 2 S 0	W 1 P 1 S 0	ENLIGHTENED LADY - May be rounding back to form. She was gone nearly 3 months and came back with a couple of dull races in July but perked up to rally for second at 20-1 in a spot like this at Del Mar on Aug. 27. She won over this track on March 18.
<b>ST31</b> W 3 P 2 S 7	W 1 P 1 S 2	RECESS - Has the look of a contender. She rallied to win a similar race at Del Mar on July 29 before finishing sixth there on Aug. 27. She rebounded at Fairplex, though, finishing third on Sept. 17 and second on Sept. 25.
<b>ST16</b> W 2 P 5 S 3	W 0 P 1 S 2	SUNNY PEACE (GB) - May be the one to beat. She has speed and drops in class. She finished fifth for \$35,000 on Del Mar turf on Aug. 14 after being freshened for a couple of months, then set the pace and ran third on the main track there for \$16,000 on Sept. 2.
<b>ST16</b> W 3 P 2 S 3	W 1 P 0 S 1	OUR STORM - Is capable of better. She won twice routing here in the spring and after being freshened a couple of months came back to rally for third at this level at Del Mar on July 29 (today's foe Recess won). However, she ran ninth there on Aug. 27.
<b>ST13</b> W 1 P 4 S 1	W 0 P 1 S 0	SOLDIER BETTY - Warrants respect. She came back after 2 1/2 months on the bench to be only ninth for \$18,000 at Del Mar on Aug. 26 but rallied well to be second when dropped there on Sept. 7. She's done her best work here (lone win, 3 of her 4 seconds).
<b>ST16</b> W 2 P 3 S 2	W 0 P 1 S 0	WONDROUS EVENT - Perked up some when a decent fifth for \$12,500 at Del Mar on Aug. 12 but failed to duplicate that when eighth in a spot like this there on Aug. 27. Her best form (both wins, all 3 seconds) have come on turf and she hasn't won since 2007.
<b>ST19</b> W 2 P 2 S 3	W 1 P 0 S 0	SAINT'S CROWN - Brings speed to this race. She won a maiden race sprinting here in April and opened up and ran fourth in a spot like this at Del Mar on Aug. 27. After that, she was rank, clipped heels and failed to finish at Fairplex on Sept. 17.
<b>ST22</b> W 3 P 3 S 1	W 0 P 0 S 0	HAWAIIAN AFLEET - Broke slowly and had traffic troubles on the far turn before finishing fourth at this level at Fairplex on Sept. 17. She lures top rider Rafael Bejarano under whom she rallied for second routing for \$16,000 here on March 27.

<b>ST34</b> W 9 P 10 S 2	W 1 P 2 S 1	SURF TOWN - Could be a factor. This 5-year-old has speed, though he faltered a bit to finish fifth in his last run on the main track at Del Mar on Aug. 30. He drops a notch in class and moves to turf which he may prefer (5 of his 9 wins have come on turf).
<b>ST18</b> W 2 P 1 S 3	W 0 P 0 S 1	DEADSHOT KEEN (IRE) - Has the look of an outsider. He was sidelined for nearly 17 months and failed to threaten in his 2 comeback starts, finishing fifth both times on the turf at Del Mar in August. His last victory came in November 2007.
<b>ST53</b> W 8 P 12 S 9	W 2 P 2 S 0	SOUPY - Remains a real pro at age 8. He's won 2 of his last 3 including rallying to win a race like this on the turf at Del Mar on Sept. 5 (today's foe Yes It's a Cat ran second). He's run well on this course (6 for 12 in the exacta).
<b>ST17</b> W 4 P 3 S 2	W 1 P 2 S 0	YES IT'S A CAT - Deserves strong consideration. He comes here sharp, having won a sprint on the Hollywood Park turf on June 14 before a pair of seconds at Del Mar at this level. He was beaten just a neck by today's foe Soupy in his Sept. 5 start there.
<b>ST38</b> W 8 P 11 S 0	W 2 P 0 S 0	MINISTER BLAIR - Was once a real tough customer but may not be quite the same. After a strong few seasons (8 wins) this 8-year-old was sidelined over a year but came back to run tenth and seventh in a pair of Del Mar starts in August.
<b>ST 7</b> W 2 P 2 S 1	W 2 P 2 S 1	BEST OF INTENTIONS - Continues his fine form and showed he can do well on turf. He won a maiden race on Hollywood Park's synthetic track and beat winners on Del Mar's main track. After that, he ran second in his first turf try at Del Mar on Sept. 2.
<b>ST20</b> W 4 P 5 S 0	W 1 P 1 S 0	WILD DIPLOMAT - Belongs on the list of contenders. He's coming into this race fresh, having not competed since finishing a game second for \$40,000 on the Del Mar turf Aug. 16. He won 3 in a row on this turf course during the winter/spring meet.
<b>ST22</b> W 4 P 1 S 3	W 0 P 0 S 1	NIMA'S PAD - Finished eighth in a stakes race on the turf at Del Mar on July 26, then ran sixth on the main track there for \$40,000 on Aug. 30. He's 0 for 5 on the turf but did finish a respectable fourth in Hollywood Park's Khaled Stakes on the turf April 25.

ST 2 W 0 P 0 S 0	W 0 P 0 S 0	SOMBRE - Finished seventh in her career debut at Del Mar on Aug. 13, then ran sixth at Fairplex on Sept. 16. Improvement is necessary. Perhaps she will do better on this track. Her dam was a 3-time stakes winner.

ST 3 W 0 P 0 S 0	W 0 P 0 S 0	CISCO'S GIRL - Has the look of a longshot. She finished tenth when unveiled at Hollywood Park on July 17, ran eleventh at Del Mar on Aug. 2, then finished tenth at Fairplex on Sept. 11.
ST20 W 0 P 1 S 2	W 0 P 1 S 1	DANIELLA ROTH - Could have a big say in this race. She ran third at Del Mar on Aug. 14, ended up second at Fairplex on Sept. 13, then finished seventh at Fairplex on Sept. 26.
