<p><u><i>1 Fund Raiser 11/05/09</i></u> <i>Second time Starter</i></p> <p><i>This Harlan's Holiday looks and acts like a runner. Out of a Sunny Clime mare that I believe was a Brian Mayberry special. She had a weak pattern for Baffert going into debut but has since flourished. She is ready!</i></p> <p><u><i>new Fund Raiser 10/30/09 OSA 59.2</i></u></p> <p><i>Was outstanding here and worked superbly for Baffert. Looks great with sharp flesh and color. Was in hand and seems to have moved way forward after debut.</i> <i>Looks good. ****</i></p> <p><u><i>Gilded Gem 11/05/09</i></u> <i>First Time Starter Analysis</i></p> <p><i>Twenty six furlongs in 30 days. Good pattern but with Baffert's second string. Working with the likes of Miss Wined Up, who ended up needing a race first out. Out of twenty year old mare. Half to seven winners, including Golden Ballet, who won over \$700,000 from six wins in ten starts. Mare was unraced. More dirt</i></p>

breeding here. Should be blessed with quick feet.

new Gilded Gem 10/22/09 HOL 59.4

*Has been training with some stamina and went well here in 35.2 for the last three furlongs. Looked OK. ****

Madel 11/05/09

First Time Starter Analysis

Good , strong foundation for Armstrong, who seems to know how to get youngsters fit and conditioned for their debuts. She fires at 21% so she is doing something right. More Than Ready filly has three straight six furlong works. She is fit with 27 furlongs in last 30 days. Good Foundation.

new Madel 10/31/09 OSA 47.4

*Looked OK here in short work. Finished well enough in the lane. More than Ready filly seems to have some ability. ****

new Richelle's Joy 11/01/09 OSA 48.4

*Was digging and trying down the lane here. Ran respectable down the hill and seems to have some quality. Finished OK here. **1/2*

Richelle's Joy 10/11/09 OSA 100.4

Worked well finishing down the lane in strong manner. Went in 13.1 and 37.1. Finished final 1/4 in 23.1. Looked strong late.

Sabina Fay 10/07/09 HOL 59.8

started out easy down the backside and finished very well through the lane for Shirreffs. Finished the final 1/4 in 23.4.

Race 2: Maiden-Claiming \$50,000.

A decent foundation 20 furlongs in 30 days is acceptable. Check for some talent in the morning.

2 Blackman Bay 11/05/09

First Time Starter Analysis

Bred to win early and has a good foundation for a barn that is not really known to fire with first time starters, however, Bernstein has done more with this one than in the past with other unraced maidens. 30 furlongs in 30 days, so fitness is not in the question. Two six furlongs works with the second being fast is always a good sign. Interesting that this race for \$50,000 to \$40,000 tag. Yet, Bernstein, doesn't try to make this one eligible for the starter allowance series by running for \$40,000. He thinks something of this one.

new Blackman Bay 11/01/09 OSA 38

*Worked from the gate for Bernstein and finished in 48.3 on the gallop out here.
Looked OK. ****

C R Magic Man 11/05/09

First Time Starter Analysis

light, light pattern with 13 furlongs in 30 days. Trained for speed. Only two five furlongs works here. There is a gap of missing works from 10/05 to 10/21. My thoughts are brief speed and tire. Fit for four furlongs.

Lone Justice 11/05/09

First Time Starter Analysis

doesn't have a strong pattern with 17 furlongs in 30 days. He was gelded After July 28 work. He may need a race or he just made the race go.

Ministers Altarboy 11/05/09

First Time Starter Analysis

Sadler sends them fit. Hr has had this homebred at Hollywood and given it 26 furlongs in 30 days. Also, Tommy Town sends them well broke to Sadler. I question this stallion's ability to sire a good horse.

new Ministers Altarboy 10/22/09 HOL 114.6

*was green and being asked to finish down the lane here for Sadler. Finished under pressure out. Needs cheapies. ***

Swiss Currency 11/05/09

*First Time Starter Analysis Carla Gaines is one of the hardest conditioners to get a line on in the morning. She somehow gets these horses ready and at times you rarely see them. She put 26 furlongs in 30 days in this son of Hold That Tiger. She has two six furlong works and could be dangerous here. She fires with horses that just don't show much in the morning, and she is very good, 20%, with maiden-claimer. **1/2*

new Swiss Currency 10/17/09 OSA 114.2

ended up in company joining On The Cover and Alpine Warrior, who were working from the gate. Went Ok while three wide throughout here. Not bad hooking into a gate team with some speed.

Thrice the Vice 11/05/09

First Time Starter Analysis

Also well versed with 25 furlongs in 30 days. Last work was good and has been mostly in company. Out of the brilliant mare Twice The Vice. Interestingly enough this one was sold privately. T.R. Bell is not known for his cranking of young horses and often they need a race. No gate works from this barn just tells me she has done enough to satisfy trainer. Think this one may need one or two.

new Thrice the Vice 10/30/09 OSA 100.4

Worked with Padre John, a High Demand two-year-old, and went in best here in 100.4. Went 35.4 for the first three furlongs. Went well. Not bad. ***

new Thrice the Vice 10/23/09 OSA 115.6

With Padre John here for Bell. They went more like 113.4 together. Splits of 24, 37.3 and finished in 113.4. Finished well going 36.1 for the last three furlongs. Has stamina and trained well.

Race 3: Claiming \$12,500 N2L

Non-winners of two claimers are the lowest types of horses on the track. Horses that work strongly and still in this level are morning glories. Treat carefully.

3 new Asay Creek 10/16/09 OSA 59.2

Worked well here for Mullins. Showed big speed in 34.1 and then finished in 59.4. Final 1/4 in 25.3. ***

new El Adelantado 10/23/09 OSA 48.6

Worked with claiming type Flashy Traveler and both went in 11.4, 35.4 breezing and out in 49.1. Looked good here.

new Oscar the Mayor 10/31/09 OSA 101

Looked average here and we have no problem with that. We think less is more in these works. Went in 101 and was going evenly.

new Practical Magic 10/23/09 OSA 58.8

Being tapped on the shoulder to finish here. Went in 58 and change, but work didn't look as good visually. Big speed early. ***

Race 4: Maiden-Claiming \$32,000.

Speed wins maiden-claiming races, maidens, period. look for some ability to handle pace. Form in the morning is best noted as best of the worst.

4 Beltian White 11/05/09

Second time Starter

Showed no speed at all after bad start at Pomona in a four furlong event. You sneeze at the gate over there and you are done. Isn't much to look at and already has blinkers and everything. Need to wake up. Pass.

new Beltian White 10/24/09 OSA 103.8

Lightly made chestnut for Sise just went in handy manner early, and then flopped home in slow manner. *1/2

Gorky's Secret 10/16/09 OSA 48.2

Worked from the pole and was leaning in through the lane. Finished in 48.4.

Gorky's Secret 08/13/09 DMR 50.2

Worked with Tonka T and got a bogus time here officially we had 22.4 34.2 and 48 flat. Short brief speed and lack of finish. If you missed the first 1/4 it can be easy to give 50 for sure.

Grant Marty Adream 11/05/09***Second time Starter***

Came in to debut with an average pattern of 21 furlongs in 30 days. All slow works. Ran slow after flashing a little speed versus slow pace. In maintenance since and Bejarano sticks with. Homebred can improve. She is half to Grant Marty A Wish, who earned \$291,366 in nine wins from twenty one starts.

Herecomesbridget 11/05/09***Second time Starter***

Bob Bean tries. He is out there every day and it has to be hard to train horses like this. This one needs a van to Arapahoe Park. Only thing I can say the five furlong work on 10/17 was bit better than the time, but not by much.

new Herecomesbridget 10/31/09 OSA 103.8

Not much here and was going slow through the lane. May need another zip code.

Lisa Lulu 11/05/09***Second time Starter***

Barn just doesn't push horses in the morning. Came in to debut with 20 furlong in 30 days and a 59.4hg out of the gate at Del Mar. Seemed like a lot of horses were working fast at Del Mar at the end of the meet. Should be tighter?

new Lisa Lulu 10/29/09 OSA 102.6

*Worked with Paddy's Magic and both went in 37 early and then finished under pressure down the lane. Lisa tried to rally but couldn't really muster much of a charge. Went final 1/4 in 25 flat. ***

Pocatello Wild Kat 11/05/09***Second time Starter***

Had 21 furlongs in 30 days heading into debut, two six furlong works, but failed to show anything and broke slow to boot versus straight maidens. More realistic today.

new Pocatello Wild Kat 10/30/09 OSA 102.6

*Lightly made filly here and she finished under mild pressure down the lane. Looked OK here for this level, but she didn't make any impression here. ***

new Pocatello Wild Kat 10/21/09 OSA 102.2

No finish down the lane and looked average. Pass for now.

Pure Confection 11/05/09

Second time Starter

*Blocky looking Candy Ride filly. She is out of the great Paseana's lineage (grandmother). Debut for \$75,000 which can be glorified \$40,000 maiden-claiming events. She was off slow and slow. Been in an holding pattern since.

new Pure Confection 11/01/09 OSA 48.8

*Chunky bay here was going through a maintenance half mile. She looks like a Candy Ride, compact and more like a sprinter. Went OK. ***

Tenacious Tina 11/05/09

First Time Starter Analysis

Clifford Sise is excellent with first time starters like this. She has 23 furlongs in 30 days and speed. Her 10/30 work was strong for this level. She is a half to Extravagant, the only other foal from this mare. Extravagant won 2 of 8 for \$24,942

new Tenacious Tina 10/30/09 OSA 100.2

We really liked this gate work from this Benchmark filly for Sise. She worked in 23.4, 47 and 58.4. Like the way she finished off work in 11.4 for the final furlong. Small, and light in the flesh. She is built that way, but can run some. She fits here. **

new Tenacious Tina 10/23/09 OSA 114.4

Dark bay filly went the last half mile in 48.4 and final ¼ in 24 flat. She had some run here after going easily early. We know she has speed, and not bad drill for maiden-claimer.

new Tenacious Tina 10/16/09 OSA 101.8

Test driven here a bit and went decently while much the best. Went in 36.4 and 101.4. Did it in hand.

Warren's too Cool 11/05/09

Second time Starter

Came into debut with a nonchalant pattern. 20 furlongs in 30 days and raced respectably. No speed and came rolling late at 100-1, of course in the finale and in the Super High Five. Has caught the eye in how she moves in gallops. Needs to improve, but....

new Warren's too Cool 10/30/09 OSA 48

*Mongol Warrior filly makes a good appearance coat and flesh wise. Went in 48 and in hand here. Seemed to be doing best. **1/2*

new Warren's too Cool 10/23/09 OSA 50

Not bad here at all in short maintenance drill. Was going very easy. Has some run.

RACE 5: Allowance/Optional Claiming.

Demand good form, and even works before last race.

5 Dotsy Jean 10/08/09 HOL 113.2

Hooked in with another Jones runner and really caught the eye blowing by workmate here. Went in sharp manner finishing in 11.4 for the last furlong.

Looked real good. Follow.

Dotsy Jean 09/26/09 HOL 49.6

Worked well and looked very good physically as she did on Sep. 20 too. Follow.

new G's Heavenly Union 10/31/09 OSA 48.8

*Sent out for a maintenance move off light tab for a layoff. In hand for Gary. ****

new G's Heavenly Union 10/24/09 OSA 59.4

Worked well here for Stevens and finished in 35.3. Final ¼ in 23.4. Looked OK here.

new G's Heavenly Union 10/17/09 OSA 100.4

Worked with good energy here for Stevens and finished easily down the lane. Looked good.

Good Time Sally 09/26/09 HOL 100.2

Worked well as she went off easily in 13 flat early. Joined by a team at the half and then blew by them and pulled away in the stretch. Went in 47.2 for the last half. Final ¼ in 24 flat. Very good work.

new Once Upon A Grace (IRE) 10/30/09 OSA 35.8

*Was doing well here inside of Into The Wild here for Cecil in 35.4 to the wire. Looked OK inside of mate in maintenance work. ****

Race 6: Claiming \$10,000.

Less is more at this level. Some works are OK, but more of light maintenance is recommended. Fast works are usually a negative for me. i.e. Deluxe Cat's fast work before last (see below). The rule of thumb is next time out is the time to follow.

6 new Changing (ARG) 10/24/09 OSA 100.6

*Worked from the gate and was joined by Celestial Topper from the Hendricks barn. Went in 23.2, 35.2, 47.1 and 59.2. Finished in 111.4. one of those Avila type gates. Fast. ****

Deluxe Cat 10/16/09 OSA 58.4

Worked with splits of 11.3 22.4 and 34 flat early. Finished in 58.1 and 112.2. Galloped out in 127.1. Tapped on shoulder. Big work for this guy. Would have liked to see this one come out of the stall the next day.

new Legendary Mud 10/30/09 OSA 59.8

Fast work but we thought this one really slowed down late, so must have gone off very quick. Went OK here but a little too much for a claimer like her. **1/2

new Legendary Mud 10/23/09 OSA 48.4

Finished on own down the lane here for Monteleone. Claiming maintenance drill.

new Stomp Dance 10/21/09 OSA 101.4

In company here with indiarara and both went the last half mile in 48.4. Splits of 13, 36.3 and 48.3. Both on even terms **

Race 7: Allowance/Optional claiming.

Demand good form in the morning.

7 new Banner Lodge 10/22/09 HOL 114

A very good workhorse for Sadler and was going strongly late here. Finished well down the lane. ***

Cherokee Heaven 09/25/09 HOL 115

worked well and liked the way this bay horse came home. Went slow early in 26 37.4 and finished in 101.4 and out in 114.4. Good work over this track.

Cherokee Heaven 09/20/09 HOL 115.6

Track was dead this morning and this guy did it well for Jones. Seems to be close to being ready.

El Gato Malo 09/02/09 DMR 112.8

Worked from the pole on the grass and went easy early in 24.3 37 49.3 and finished in 112.2. Final 1/4 in 22.4. Big finish. Also key drill on August 23 with big finish.

new Machismo 10/28/09 HOL 112.8

We had this one going in 100.1 and out in 112 and chnage. Showed good run here and finished OK. Finished in full stride. Four six furlong works here for comeback.

new Machismo 10/22/09 HOL 113.8

Was going the last three furlongs in 36 flat. Looked good and finished well on own

late.

new Muny 10/25/09 OSA 113.4

Worked on the grass course for Pupye and jumped in with Tenga Cat and later joined by Polonius. Began 8 lengths behind Tenga Cat and finished two behind. Had a lot to do and 'Cat went like 50.4 early, so no chance for this one to catch him. Was ridden out late. Will get something out of this drill. ***

new Talkin to Mom Roo 10/23/09 OSA 58.8

We had this guy in 59 flat and finished strongly late for West. Splits of 12.1, and 35.2. Hard knocking type went well. ***

new Tenga Cat 10/25/09 OSA 114.4

Big, black horse for Ellis is as handsome as talented. Joined by Muny, and Polonius. Muny was always three back, and Polonius jumped in at the half with speed. 'Cat was unaffected and went easily in 50.4 and 114.2 breezing. Nice work and not allowed to explode in the lane. Looks good. ***

Tenga Cat 09/23/09 HOL 114

Good drill here finishing in 48 and change on a dead track at Hollywood. This one is a real good horse and is developing. Horrible wide trip in Green Flash. He looks like he is ready.

new Usurp 10/25/09 OSA 115.8

Went an easy six furlongs on the turf. He was all by himself and went slow for the first furlong, but finished in 101 flat. Looked OK. **1/2

Race 8: Maiden-claiming.

The bottom level for maiden-claimers and going a distance of ground to boot.

8 Baracho 10/11/09 HOL 47

looked good in the early stages of the work going off in 23 flat for the first 1/4. Finished ok through the lane in 47 flat.

new Circle Diamond 11/01/09 OSA 49.2

Was striding out decently through the lane. He has never looked like a quality colt even though he has trained decent all along. He needs to be worked and may be lazy. Gangly, too.

Circle Diamond 10/04/09 OSA 128

Flashy type with lots of chrome takes time to get uncorked that's why we like stablemate more and can do better. Was one paced here this morning.

Circle Diamond 08/17/09 DMR 111.2

Worked from the pole with Unbridled Papillon a good looking older grey and

went the last five furlongs here in 59.3. Finished decently outside of mate.

Circle Diamond 08/14/08 DMR 101

finished well enough down the lane and in full stride to the wire. Flashy sort.

Circle Diamond 08/08/08 DMR 48.4

can do better here as workmate Dogmatic went well here and finished big out.
Needs some improvement with seasoning.
