RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: Let's start with the second-timers. **Top Seeded** made a good mid-race move when ending up the third head on the wire in her Oct 2 debut with \$50,000 Maiden-Claimers Oct 2, a race rated at this same RCL. The O'Neill trainee is now protected with this move to the Cal-bred Maiden ranks, plots on top and gets a good outside draw. She's strictly the one to beat. **Stunning Ally** gets blinkers following a troubled Oct 10 debut. She ran in spots, though, and Canani is much more dangerous with second-

timers than rookies. She took strong betting action the first time around and may offer more value today. Those two will share equal billing. **Evening Jewel** beat **Ally** home in that Oct 10 affair and is a threat right back, while **Usually Super** has trained as if she's ready to go in her debut for the ever-dangerous Carla Gaines. **Analysis by Rick Lochner**

HORSE COMMENTS

Shesprovocative has chased the pace and tired in her last pair, so perhaps "blinkers off" will help her relax early and better ration her speed. Perhaps.

Evening Jewel improved a bit when dropped in with state-breds Oct 10, as she got up for place money. Cassidy races his stock into shape and this one can improve some more.

Heavens A Raging was pitched against Maiden turf sprinters in an Oct 25 jail run and once again chased the pace and tired. These state-breds are a better fit, but she needs to show some stamina. She shows no works since being claimed Oct 2.

Bonita Montana debuts for Blincoe, but he races his few rookies into shape, or at least he has over the last few years. This one has solid win-early credentials as a daughter of Bertrando and three of her five siblings to race were multiple winners. She arrives boasting back-to-back gate works, so she rates an outside look (10/1 or better).

Stunning Ally was heavily bet in her Oct 10 debut even though Canani rarely strikes with a first-timer. She ran on to split the field after running into trouble on the turn. Julio is much more dangerous with horses that have had a race and this one may validate her strong support today. "Blinkers on" may help, too.

Usually Super is her Stakes-winning dam's first foal and Gaines is dangerous with first-timers. This one has gotten fit quickly (only six works, but the last four were at 5F or greater). She's a contender.

Twistthenightaway has worked nine times since Aug 7 and her recent drills have all been stamina-builders. Two of her four siblings to race where multiple winners of modest amounts and she's one to watch for later.

Top Seeded broke sharply debuting Oct 2, but was allowed to settle from the outside before surging between horses to be the 3rd head on the wire. That race has already produced two next-out winners, including winner Sandy Cheeks, and O'Neill does well with this kind. She's the one to beat on paper.

TODAY'S BETTER THAN LOOKED HORSES

(3rd)-Stunning Ally (10/10-5th) Canani doesn't win with first time starters anymore, but he had this one cranked up pretty well only to have circumstances took a toll. She was stuck in traffic and her rider had to hit the brakes. She got outside to make a run around the turn and then finished steadily while no doubt too short to overcome the early trouble.

HOW TO READ TRACK BIAS

The main track can be biased toward front-runners or late-runners and/or horses racing on the inside or outside part of the track. To define how the track was playing we've added a track bias column in the data lines. The following symbols will be used in that column:

An F = A Front-runner's or speed bias
 An L = A Late-runner's or closer's bias
 An I = An Inside bias
 An O = An Outside bias

Each will carry a modifier of 1 (moderate), 2 (strong) or 3 (dominant).

Turf races may have a frontrunners or late-runner's bias as well as an indication whether the auxiliary rails were up (up) or down (dn)

Examples: F1/O3 = Moderate Frontrunner and dominant outside biases.
 L2/DN = Strong Late-runners and the rails were down on the turf.
